An explanation of the scoring system used by teachers when completing the Headmasters Reports:

Diligence Mark (1-10)

10 – Outstanding

9 – Excellent

8 - Very Good

7- Good

6 - Satisfactory - Room for improvement

5 - Unsatisfactory

4 - Disappointing

1-3 Cause for immediate concern and follow up contact with parents may be necessary.

When calculating scores for diligence teachers will take into account: Organisation, class-work (including participation, attentiveness etc.), homework/themes, class tests, discipline/behaviour.

Attainment Grade

Attainment grades are based on the scoring system used in the public exam system.

For **Elements, Rudiments and Grammar** the following grades apply:

Higher Level - A ,B,C,D,E,F,NG

Ordinary Level - a, b, c, d, e, f, ng

Foundation Level af, bf, cf, df, ef, ff, ngf

For **Syntax, Poetry and Rhetoric** the following grades apply:

Higher Level - H1,H2, H3,H4,H5,H6,H7,H8

Ordinary Level - 01, 02, 03,04,05,06,07,08

Foundation Level - F1, F2, F3, F4.F5,F6,F7,F8

The grade is an assessment of the students' work over the previous five weeks and should not be seen as a projected grade for public examinations. A student's scores will not be based on results of class tests alone, although they may form an important part of the scoring.
