

LIBRARY POLICY & RHETORIC STUDY

The Library is first and foremost a resource for the whole school facilitating a number of groups, activities and events;

- Teachers schedule library classes
- Teachers schedule subject classes
- TY Outreach to local Evergreens group occurs here every Tues. afternoon
- Authors and a variety of speakers use the space when visiting

The use of the Library as a study space for Rhetoric during class time must happen **around** all of the other uses. This should be possible <u>much of the time</u> but you cannot assume the space is free for your use. <u>Take direction from the Librarian as to its availability or</u> otherwise.

There are clear and strict protocols relating to the use of the Library. These protocols ensure the library remains a consistently pleasant study/work environment for everyone;

- Respect the resources and furnishings
- Do not bring food or drinks into the Library
- Do not bring bags into the Library
- Communicate using the appropriate noise level no more than a whisper while studying
- Dispose of litter (paper, pencil parings etc.) in the bins provided
- Library books only to be removed from the library when scanned onto your library account.

Any Rhetoric student who does not adhere to these protocols will have sanctions imposed.
